LIBRARY CARD

Readers need practice in school and at home to become better readers.

Choose books to read on your own and others to read aloud or have read aloud to you.

Ask librarians or media specialists to recommend books. Read and view the books and other sources of information that rely on photos, slideshows and videos, and discuss different approaches to storytelling.

Take advantage of programs that your library organizes for young readers, and ask for the schedule and description of events that libraries offer to support young readers, during the summer and all year long.

To take home resources from your public library, you only need your library card, called a SMART card in NC, for access to materials that the library provides. Simply visit your library and sign up for your card.
